

In 1995 a group of people came together in Lincoln to discuss their jobsthe handling of evidence. We talked about the need for training and the need to get to know and communicate with other people doing the same job and facing the same problems.

In 1996, the Nebraska Association of Property and Evidence, NAPE, was formed. Bylaws were written, articles of incorporation were filed with the State, and an executive board was elected.

Training-Information-Ideas

Each year NAPE holds a conference somewhere in the state of Nebraska. At these conferences, members and guests hear a speaker, participate in a project, or tour a Law Enforcement facility with the idea of sharing information. Ideas about evidence storage issues, safety, disposal, and other evidence topics. Vendor materials are often available and prize drawings are a fun part of the gathering. - A mock crime scene and trial have been held for practical training.
- NAPE has also hosted two and three day training seminars, given by noted evidence expert Bob Duran, author of "The Police Property Control function."
